



# Dress Code Policy

## Overview

Our dress code aims to uphold the club's prestigious atmosphere while embracing modern style and comfort. We encourage members to dress tastefully and appropriately for different areas of the club to ensure an inclusive environment that respects our heritage and contemporary lifestyles.

## General Guidelines

- Members and their guests are expected to maintain a neat, well-groomed appearance at all times.
- Clothing should be clean, free of tears, and not overly casual or sporty.
- Not permitted: Sportswear (e.g., sports trainers, athletic shorts, track suits, football kits), flip flops or beach sandals, hats and caps.

## Bar and Snooker Room

- Smart Casual is the standard in these relaxed settings.
- Permitted:
  - Trousers, chinos, skirts or dresses.
  - Jeans: Smart jeans without rips or heavy distressing.
  - Tops: T-shirts, polo shirts, jumpers (smart, plain or minimally branded), casual shirts, blouses.
  - Shorts: Tailored shorts are acceptable.
  - Footwear: Shoes, loafers, dress trainers, smart sandals.

### Dining Room

- Smart Dress Code is requested in the dining area to preserve a sophisticated dining experience.
- Men are encouraged to wear:
  - Trousers or chinos.
  - Jeans: Smart jeans without rips or heavy distressing.
  - Tops: Collared shirts; a jacket or blazer is strongly recommended.
  - Footwear: Shoes, loafers.
- Ladies are encouraged to wear:
  - Smart dresses, skirts, or trousers.
  - Jeans: Smart jeans without rips or heavy distressing.
  - Tops: Blouses, jumpers, cardigans, jackets or wraps.
  - Footwear: Smart evening flats or heels.
- Not Permitted:
  - T-shirts, shorts, trainers.

### Club Events

Special events may have specific dress codes depending on the occasion. These will be communicated in advance.

### Compliance

Staff may discreetly address non-compliance with the dress code, and members are expected to cooperate fully. Suggestions or concerns about the dress code should be directed to the management for consideration.
